Meter Reader

Manitoba Hydro Utility Services (MHUS) is a subsidiary of Manitoba Hydro and is contracted by the utility to provide meter reading and other services. Work experience gained at MHUS is considered an asset when applying for work at Manitoba Hydro, particularly in the gas trades area. MHUS' main recruitment efforts are undertaken in the spring, when casual employees are hired to fill in for employees moving to seasonal work in other areas.

Meter readers read both outdoor and indoor electric and natural gas meters using a handheld computer. They can work in Winnipeg as well as many rural districts.

Meter reading may be the career for you if you:

- have great customer service skills;
- are capable of working independently as well as in a team;
- enjoy working outdoors in all weather conditions;
- enjoy walking an average of 5 to 7 hours each day.

Qualifications:

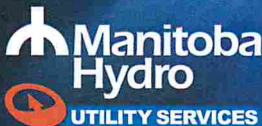
- High School or Mature Student Diploma;
- Valid Class 5 Driver's Licence (must possess your own vehicle for work).

MHUS also provides mileage reimbursement for employees as they are required to use their own vehicles.

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Gas Trades Training Programs

Maintenance Trainee (4 year apprenticeship)

Duties include maintenance, repair, construction, modification, and inspection of the natural gas distribution and transmission systems including pipelines, meter installations, pressure control installations, and related facilities.*

Service Person Trainee (4 year apprenticeship)

Works both indoors and outdoors in domestic dwellings, commercial buildings, public property and streets. Monitors and maintains natural gas distribution systems, responds to natural gas related emergencies, locates company underground natural gas and electrical lines, and services and inspects natural gas appliances.**

General Trades Person

Multi-skilled in areas requiring temporary and/or seasonal work. A diverse skill set is required therefore the GTP may be deployed to areas that are appropriate with individual capabilities and the outlined qualifications required to do specific work.

Qualifications:

- Minimum Grade 12 or equivalent;
- Demonstrated mechanical aptitude;
- Related work experience is an asset;
- Able to work at heights and in confined spaces;
- Possess a valid Class 5 driver's licence (intermediate or full) and eligibility to obtain a Class 3 licence.

* Must attain endorsement for towing trailers over 4,540 kg and successfully attain a Class 3 licence.

** Must have completed the following courses to qualify: Mathematics 40S (Applied or Pre-Calculus); Physics 30S; and English 40.
