Just a reminder to all when moving snow from your driveways across or along road allowances, to make sure you push all of the excess snow off road ways. When clearing the snow off your property, it is important to make sure that none of the snow you are pushing off your property is left on Municipal Roads and Road Allowances. When this happens, the ice and snow become traffic hazards and make it difficult and dangerous for the snow plows to clear properly. We all want cleared driveways, but we need to keep our roads cleared too!

Spring Road Restrictions:

The RM of Piney will be imposing spring road restrictions commencing mid-March 2014. Dates for these road restrictions will correspond with the Provincial Road Restrictions.

Windrows in Driveways:

The RM of Piney has received numerous calls in regards to the windrows left in residents driveways. Windrows are not the responsibility of the RM to remove and are to be taken care of by the home owner. There are thousands of driveways within our municipality and if we were to have our grader operators take a minute on each driveway to clear these windrows, there would be astronomical costs involved that would have to be covered by the rate payers. The RM is focused on clearing the roads and cannot justify the time necessary to remove windrows from resident's driveways.
