

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PINEY
BY-LAW NO. 85/2012

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF
PINEY TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 74/2011.

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Piney wishes to amend By-Law No. 74/2011 to reflect the ability of a Peace Officer to destroy a dog that is causing an immediate risk to any person, property or any other animal.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Piney in meeting duly assembled enacts the following:

THAT By-Law No. 74/2011 is amended by changing Section 14 (2) as follows:

14(2) In the event that an animal is causing an immediate risk to any person, property or any other animal, the By-Law Enforcement / Animal Control Officer or Peace Officer is authorized to apprehend and impound or, in the absolute discretion of the By-Law Enforcement / Animal Control Officer or Peace Officer, destroy the said animal notwithstanding that it has not been declared to be a dangerous animal by the R.M. at the time of its apprehension and impoundment.
