### Spring Road Restrictions

Further notifications to follow

Weight restrictions are implemented each spring to protect municipal roads susceptible to damage during spring thaw. The RM of Piney would like to provide notice that some municipal roads within the RM of Piney will have 65% weight restrictions this spring, approximately the same time as the Provincial weight restrictions. Restrictions will remain in place as long as necessary and depend upon spring weather conditions.

Further notifications will follow with details on which roads will be restricted and specifically when restrictions will come into effect. The RM of Piney appreciates everyone's cooperation in complying with the spring restrictions. Funding for road repairs come from your tax dollars. Protecting our roads is a benefit to all ratepayers of the RM.

### Recycling

Proper usage for blue bags

Please remember the blue bags are for recycling and not household garbage. Some blue bags have been found in the garbage dumps with household garbage in them. Blue bags must be used for blue bag recycling. These bags are specified by our contractor as a way to properly distinguish between garbage and recycling.

### Recyclable items that belong in these bags include:

Newspapers, Flyers (loose), Magazines, Telephone Books (loose), Boxboard, Cereal Boxes (flattened), Cardboard (flattened, boxes empty), Milk Cartons, Juice Boxes (rinsed), Plastic Containers #1, #2, #4, #5, #7 (rinsed and caps removed), Glass Containers (rinsed and caps removed), Steel Cans (rinsed, label removed), Aluminum Cans.

### Recycling serves 2 purposes:

First, it avoids landfills and helps in reducing air and water pollution and secondly, valuable material like aluminum cans and plastic and glass are reused in other forms and not wasted. Be mindful of what you do, pay attention to the items you buy and always check yourself to see if you really need it or if it comes in a package with less waste. We can all do our part and we will make a huge difference.
