## 2016 Dust Control Program

July 2016 (weather permitting)

\$250.00 plus G.S.T.  
Payment due June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016

When requesting application of dust control, the Applicant acknowledges and accepts the following:

1. The product to be used for dust control purposes is Magnesium Chloride. The Municipality does not guarantee any dust control product.
2. For safety purposes, the maintenance of roads by the Municipality takes priority over anyone's application of dust control.
3. The Municipality shall not be responsible to replace anyone's application of dust control.

**The Rural Municipality of Piney will accept requests for the application of dust control, on a PRE-PAYMENT BASIS ONLY, on municipal roads in front of residences in the Rural Municipality of Piney.**

Ratepayers may obtain dust control on the basis of \$250.00 plus G.S.T. per application, which is 90 metres long. Orders and pre-payments are to be made to the Rural Municipality of Piney Administration Office by Friday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The application will consist of 5 meters of road width x 90 meter strip. The area to be serviced must be staked out prior to application. Dust control will be applied early July, 2016, weather permitting.

**In the event of there not being sufficient requests for a truckload, payments will be refunded.**
