Building permits can take up to two weeks for processing. When planning a construction project, please take this into consideration prior to filling out your application. Before an application can be processed, all non-shaded sections must be filled out by the applicant. The RM office will complete the shaded sections. Along with your completed application, a site plan and payment are both required. Please follow the RM of Piney Site Plan policy to ensure you have included all the required information. You can find this policy and the building permit application on the RM of Piney website. Once the office has your completed building permit application, along with your site plan and payment, your application will be processed in a timely manner.
