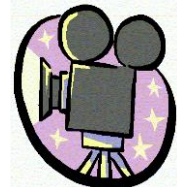

Snow Removal

Just a reminder to all when moving snow from your driveways across or along road allowances, to make sure you push all of the excess snow off road ways. When clearing the snow off your property, it is important to make sure that none of the snow you are pushing off your property is left on Municipal Roads and Road Allowances. When this happens, the ice and snow become traffic hazards and make it difficult for the snow plows to clear properly.

Fire Prevention in Winter

Now that we are enjoying winter weather with all the challenges it brings it would be wise to ensure that you, your home and your property are as safe as possible.

Fire Safety Tips during winter months:

- Have all family members aware of an escape plan and meeting place and practice regularly;
- If your residence is filled with smoke, crawl to escape as smoke is toxic and you may become disoriented in a smoky environment;
- If your smoke alarms go off or you detect smoke, get everyone out, call 911, and wait for emergency crews to respond;
- Electrical outlets should not be overloaded;
- When using extension cords, check to see that they are rated for the equipment you plan to use them for and have no breaks or damage -use power bars that will shut down if overloaded;
- Keep portable heaters, baseboards, and areas around fireplaces away from combustible materials;
- use candles with the utmost caution;
- Use a screen around fireplaces to secure sparks;
- Check and clean chimneys regularly;
- Store firewood in a responsible manner;
- Dispose of ashes using a fireproof container with a lid;
- Kitchen fires cause 49% of home fires - keep cooking area free from combustible materials such as dish towels, curtains, and flammable liquids: always stay focused on your cooking!!!
- Keep lint traps and filters in the dryer free from buildup;
- Install smoke detectors on every level of your home;
- Clear snow build up away from all exits;
- Make checking that your smoke alarms and CO detectors are working a part of your routine;

Take the time to do a regular walk about inside and outside your home to ensure that you are practicing *firesmart* techniques.



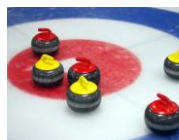
