Road Weight Restrictions

RM of Piney Public Works

Implemented: March 28th, 2017
Resolution No. 94



The RM of Piney has imposed a 65% weight restriction of normal loading on the following road sections:

- Menisino North MM (Rd 59E); PTH 12 to PR 201
- Whitemouth Lake Rd MM (Rd 21N); PR 210 to Rd 74E
- St. Labre Rd MM (Rd 27N and Rd 63E); PR 210 to Whitemouth Lake Rd (Rd 21)
- Vassar North MM from Vassar to the Junction of Whitemouth Lake Rd (Rd 20N)
- Vassar East MM (Rd 6N); Vassar East Access to PR 308
- Municipal Road 12N from PTH 12 to PR 210;

Road restrictions will remain in effect until further notice.

Municipal Road 54E Closed

Road 54E is closed from PR 201 to Rd 5N. This portion of Road 54E will remain closed until further notice.

Burning Permits

Sustainable Development



April 1st, 2017 – November 15th, 2017

Through MB Sustainable Development, burning permits are required from April 1st until November 15th, 2017 under authority of the Wildfires Act.

Burning Permits can only be obtained from your local Sustainable Development Office. **No burning is allowed before 6:00pm or when winds exceed 15 km/hour unless authorized by a Natural Resource Officer.**
