Private Well Water Testing Days 2017



The Seine-Rat River Conservation District will be assisting residents with private well water testing for the presence of E.coli and Coliform bacteria. **The cost of private well water testing is \$21.26, including taxes, per sample.** Payment may be submitted by **cash or cheque ONLY**, with cheques made payable to Horizon Lab Ltd.

Water bottles & application forms can be picked up in advance at the RM of Piney office. **Samples must be taken on the same day as the drop-off and submitted at the RM office prior to 10:00am** along with your completed application form, chain of custody form, and payment.

Private Well Water Testing Days will take place on:

Thursday, May 25th, 2017 by 10am
Thursday, June 29th, 2017 by 10am

Vassar and Sandilands waste disposal sites will be open to the public from 10:00am to 6:00pm on the following days:

These dumps will be open only for the days listed above and will only be receiving yard waste such as trees, flax straw, grass, leaves, branches, and natural debris.

Any household garbage, recycling, or any non-burnable debris will not be accepted at these dump sites.

2017 Dust Control Program

RM of Piney Public Works

When requesting application of dust control, the Applicant acknowledges and accepts the following:

- Product to be used for dust control purposes is Magnesium Chloride; RM does not guarantee any dust control product.
- For safety purposes, maintenance of RM roads takes priority over any dust control application.
- The RM shall not be responsible to replace anyone's application of dust control.

RM of Piney will accept requests for the application of dust control, on a **PRE-PAYMENT BASIS ONLY**, on municipal roads in front of residences in the RM of Piney.

Orders and pre-payments of \$250 plus GST are to be made to the RM Office by Friday, June 16th, 2017. The application will consist of 5 meters of road width x 90 meter strip. The area to be serviced must be staked out prior to application. **Dust control will be applied early July 2017, weather permitting.**

Road Weight Restrictions

RM of Piney Public Works

Implemented: March 28th, 2017
Resolution No. 94



RM of Piney has imposed a 65% weight restriction of normal loading on the following road sections:

- Menisino North MM (Rd 59E); PTH 12 to PR 201
- Whitemouth Lake MM (Rd 21N); PR 210 to Rd 74E
- St. Labre Rd MM (Rd 27N and Rd 63E); PR 210 to Whitemouth Lake Rd (Rd 21)
- Vassar North MM from Vassar to the Junction of Whitemouth Lake Rd (Rd 20N)
- Vassar East (Rd 6N); Vassar East Access to PR 308
- Municipal Road 12N from PTH 12 to PR 210;

Restrictions will remain in effect until further notice.

Be Fire Smart

OFC - MB Wildfire Program



For most of us who live in the RM of Piney, we need to know how to protect ourselves in the event of a forest fire. Avoid fires on days of low humidity, high temperatures and gusty winds. Build fires away from trees or dry bushes and **NEVER** leave a fire unattended and make sure a fire is completely out before leaving.

Don't wait for an emergency to happen, always be prepared. This requires an understanding of everyone's unique needs and supplies to last for a period of **at least 72 hours**. Always be ready to evacuate all family members including pets. Follow closely to all instructions provided by local authorities. Know where the reception centres are before leaving the evacuated area and grab all medications needed.

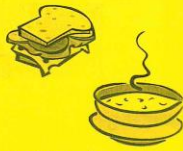
