By-Law No. 122/2017:

- Divided the municipality into zones
- Prescribes permitted and conditional uses for land and buildings in each zone
- Sets out the procedure for such things as: applying for and issuing development permits, non-conforming certificates, zoning memoranda and other similar documents, including the classes of development that do not require a development permit
- To rescind By-Law No. 80/2012;

The arena committee appreciates all the local support and looks forward to making ice again this winter.






