Land Access Permits

Hunting / Firearms By-Law No. 123/2017



Hunting/Firearms By-Law No. 123/2017 was recently passed on October 24th, 2017. This by-law, which amends By-Law 79/2012, was established to limit and control the number of individuals using and accessing municipally owned land during regular hunting seasons.

Land Access Permits can be purchased for either:

- Spring Season: \$250 (April 1st to June 21st)
- Fall Season: \$500 (September 1st to November 30th)

Land access permits are only for hunting purposes only. Recreational use of land will not be permitted under any circumstances. The information provided above only provides overview of the by-law. For complete rules and regulations, go to our website or call 204-437-2284.


