Overdue Tax Reminder

Tax Sale Deadline: Friday, March 30th, 2018

RM taxes for 2017 were due on October 31st. If you happened to miss this deadline and also have 2016 taxes still owing on your property, your property will incur tax sale costs if not paid by March 30th, 2018. For all rate payers who have 2016 and 2017 taxes owing, a letter will be issued to you in January of 2018 stating what you have owing for 2016 including arrears and penalties. This amount is due by Friday, March 30th, 2018. The letter will not state the amount due for 2017 taxes since only 2016 needs to be paid so the property will not incur additional costs. Commencing April 1st, 2018, tax sale costs will be added to your property as well as monthly penalties.

Zoning By-Law Procedures

RM of Piney

By-Law No. 122/2017 passed October 10th, 2017

The RM recently passed Zoning By-Law No. 122/2017 which regulates the use and development of land within our area. The previous Zoning By-Law No. 80/2012 has therefore been rescinded by this current by-law.

As per the by-law, zoning procedures include:

- Portable storage containers such as sea cans are now conditional in the following three zones: Limited Rural Buffer, General Development, and Rural Seasonal; Conditional use means that the storage container may only be permitted if you apply for a conditional use permit;
- Building permits and development permits are needed for structural alterations done to a building unless they are maintenance related;
- Any building erected that is larger than 108 sq. ft. will need a building and development permits;
- Permanent structures that are not an accessory to a dwelling require a development permit no matter what size the structure is.

As the owner of a property, it is your responsibility to be up-to-date with the current RM of Piney Zoning By-Law. The information provided above only provides overview of the by-law. For complete zoning rules and regulations go to www.rmofpiney.mb.ca or call 204-437-2284.
