# **Zoning By-Law - Livestock**

RM of Piney

### By-Law No. 122/2017 passed October 10th, 2017

The municipality would like to remind all rate payers of the RM of Piney that livestock operations are only allowed as per By-Law No. 122/2017 as follows:

- Livestock less than 10 animal units:
  - Allowed as Accessory use in Rural Zones 1, 2 & 3, and in Limited Rural & Limited Rural Buffer Zones;
  - Conditional use in General Development, Rural– Seasonal Residential, and in Rural Commercial / Industrial Zones:
- Livestock operations greater than 10 animal units to a maximum of 299 units:
  - Permitted in Rural Zones 1, 2 & 3, and in Limited Rural Zone;
  - o Conditional use in Limited Rural Buffer Zones;
  - Not permitted in General Development, Rural– Seasonal Residential, or Rural Commercial / Industrial Zones:
- Livestock new operations greater than 299 to a maximum of 1,200 animal units <u>OR</u> expanding operations of 299 to 1,200 animal units:
  - Conditional use in Rural Zones 1, 2 & 3, and in Limited Rural & Limited Rural Buffer Zones;
  - Not permitted in General Development, Rural– Seasonal Residential, or Rural Commercial / Industrial Zones;
