- Experience in operating small power equipment such as chainsaws, brush saws and push mowers
- Experience in operating and maintaining riding mowers, light automotive vehicles (ie. Gators, Utility), tractors with attachments
- Experience dealing directly with the public; and demonstrated ability to interact effectively with the public and co-workers and the ability to deal with stressful situations.
- Demonstrated knowledge of safe working practices.

# **Duties:**

Under the direction of the Parks Works Supervisor, the incumbent performs a variety of heavy and light manual duties associated with construction, maintenance, and works operations; including janitorial duties and general maintenance of grounds and facilities including the cleaning of screens at the Moose Lake dike control structure. The labourer will be required to operate various small equipment, light motor vehicles, power tools and chainsaws. The employee will have knowledge and understanding of the fall protection and rescue associated with the cleaning of the screens at the Moose Lake dike control structure.

The incumbent will be required to operate various equipment including wood chippers, stump grinders, specialized mowers, light duty garbage packers and tractors. The Operator will be required to perform maintenance and minor repairs on equipment, as well as keep daily operating and maintenance records. Assists the operator in charge with testing and operating the Class 1 water treatment, Class 1 Water Distribution and Class 1 Wastewater Collection systems in the park to insure that systems comply with all legal requirements and operate to meet all relevant standards and guidelines.
