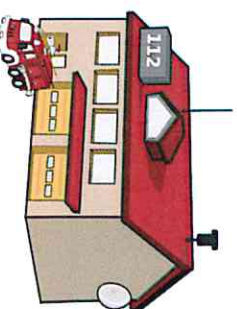

RM Office Closed for Holidays

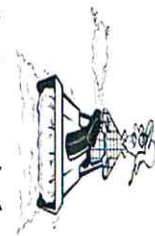
The RM of Piney Office will be closed from Noon December 24th, 2015 until Monday January 4th, 2016 for Christmas Holidays.

Snow Clearing

Just a reminder to all when moving snow from your driveways across or along road allowances, to make sure you push all of the excess snow off road ways. When clearing the snow off your property, it is important to make sure that none of the snow you are pushing off your property is left on Municipal Roads and Road Allowances. When this happens, the ice and snow become traffic hazards and make it difficult for the snow plows to clear properly. We all want cleared driveways, but we need to keep our roads cleared too!



Garbage Dumps

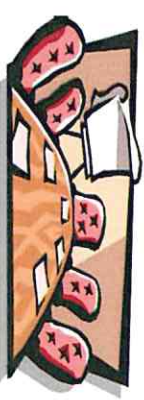
Winters hours (9:00am to 5:00pm) at all three Waste Disposal Sites will remain as stated until Sunday, March 13th, 2016. At that time, the Waste Disposal Sites will revert back to their regular hours of operation being 10:00am to 6:00pm.



The RM would also like to remind everyone that it is important not to dispose of hot ashes in the household waste pits. Dumping hot ashes in the household pits can start a fire even during the blistering winter season, so we strongly suggest letting your ashes cool completely before disposing of them.
