
REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ)

The Rural Municipality of Piney is requesting quotations from qualified contractors for the assembly and construction of three waste transfer stations; one near Sprague, one near Woodridge and one near Piney. The new waste transfer stations shall be fully functional and ready for service by September 30, 2016.

The general scope of the Work includes the following:

- Site Preparation and Grading
- Bin Wall Assembly and Backfill
- Road, Access Ramp and Turnaround Construction
- Road, Access Ramp and Turnaround Finish
- Imported Topsoil and Seeding
- Supply and Place Erosion Control Blanket
- Supply and Place Stone Rip-Rap
- Roll Off Bin Concrete Pads

The quotation is for the supply of equipment, material and labour to complete the full assembly of the proposed works. Bin type wall materials, borrow sites and shop drawings shall be provided by the RM. The successful bidder shall be responsible to meet the proposed timelines and provide sufficient labour to complete the scope of the quotation.

The Rural Municipality of Piney will normally award contracts to the lowest competent Bidder meeting the required specifications. However, the RM retains the right to reject any or all Request for Quotation (RFQ) and to take into consideration past performance of bidders on similar contracts, both in and out of the Rural Municipality of Piney and such other factors the RM considers relevant including timing of services to be provided.
