It must be fully functional, easy to navigate for all skill levels and must be developed on a simple platform. The successful proponent will fully understand the regional demands and constraints. Finally, all candidates must have proven experience in website design, development and hosting.

Scope

The scope of work required of the Proponent will include but not limited to the following:

- 1. Must utilize current web-based technology and be user friendly for staff and public
- 2. Easy to navigate
- 3. Aesthetically pleasing
- 4. Easy for staff to add content
- 5. Home page to provide clear choice of path; tourism or economic development
- Provide strong marketing of opportunities and resources
- 7. Clear drop down menus for ease of navigation between content
- 8. Search box
- 9. Relevant regional graphics and photos

- 10. Links to social media platforms used by both RMs
- 11. Allow for each municipality to maintain its individuality, yet promote and market regionally
- 12. 6 hours of onsite training and 12 months of follow up support
- 13. Service contract terms for the committee to consider after the expire of the 12 month follow up support period, including service rates
- 14. Final date for completion is no later than September 1, 2016 unless mutually agreed upon
- 15. Final ownership of content, graphics and domain name remains with the RM of Piney and Stuartburn
