Scope of Proposal:

The Rural Municipality of Piney requests proposals and quotes for the design and supply of 18 – 6 yard front load – flat top waste bins and 6 – 40 yard roll off bins. The Rural Municipality of Piney is located in the far southeast corner of Manitoba. Currently, the RM is in the process of converting three waste disposal sites to waste transfer sites. The main method of moving household waste will be with a standard front load compaction truck, with roll off bins being used for bulky material such as construction and demolition waste. The RM of Piney has a high abundance of wildlife, including bears and ravens, which tend to be problematic at the current waste disposal sites.

This RFP is for the design and supply of 18 front load bins meeting standard specifications, which include a lid design that will reduce scavenging by wildlife. The bin lids must allow for front load compaction, but allow public use from the opposite side. The lids must be easy to open and secure for operation.

Additional six stud wall roll off containers are required. The design shall include a hinged top lid formed in three sections with lift assist incorporated into the design. Each container will include an exterior ladder and interior ladder. Heavy duty door hinges, fitted with grease fitting shall be included in the design.

All containers supplied shall be painted on the interior and exterior with two coats of primer and two coats of enamel paint in a dark green color.

Proposals/quotes are to be in Canadian dollars and FOB Vassar Manitoba. Unloading at the RM of Piney shall be the responsibility of the Municipality. Those interested in this opportunity are encouraged to contact the municipality to acquire further details.

Timeline:

All bins shall be delivered no later than November 25th, 2016, unless an alternate date is mutually agreed upon.

Fees:

Proposals and fees are to be inclusive. Additional work shall be issued by RFP or letter of understanding. No funds will be released until delivery.
