2018 Tax Deadline

All 2018 RM of Piney taxes were due on October 31st, 2018. If you missed this deadline, your RM account will incur interest charges of 1.25% on the 1st day of each month following the deadline. Payments can be made online (credit unions or Caisse banks), in office (debit, cash, or cheque), by mailing a cheque, or over the phone by credit card (requires a 2% charge).

9:00am – 5:00pm

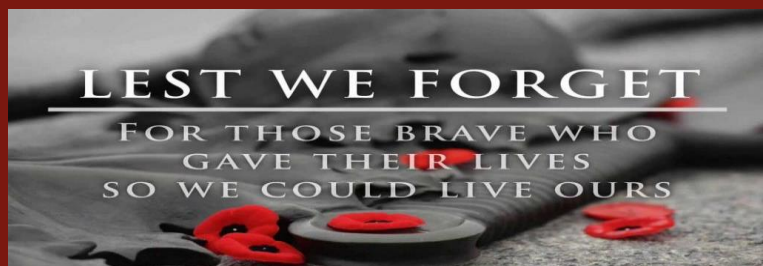

RM HIGHLIGHTS FOR NOVEMBER

RM Term Position – the RM would like to welcome Candace Hiebert to the office. She will be filling in for one of our staff, for approximately one year, as a full time receptionist. Welcome Candace!

Manitoba Health – three letters have been issued to the Minister of Health requesting a meeting regarding coverage through Altru Health Care. Letters have also been sent to our MLA in regards to this matter as well.

911 Services – 911 services provided in the RM of Piney are arranged through a yearly agreement with the City of Brandon. The RM pays for this service which is the population multiplied by the 2019 base fee of \$4.34. This agreement can be viewed at the RM office.

Sprague Fire Hall – progress has started for the addition at the Sprague Fire Hall. This project will not be completed until year 2019.

Piney Fire Hall Well – a new well was drilled at the Piney Fire Hall. This well was installed due to the old well not producing sufficient water supply.

Piney Antique Fire Truck Shelter – the RM received a grant for a picnic shelter to cover the Piney antique fire truck. This shelter will be open to the public and is located directly in front of the Piney Fire Hall.

RD 54E Ditching – the RM of Stuartburn and RM of Piney have entered into a Letter of Understanding for ditching work to be done along the inter-municipal Rd 54E near Sundown. Piney will manage the drainage project but costs will be done at a 50/50 cost share.

A Message from the RM of Piney Fire Fighters

With hunting season approaching, the deer are on the move. Here are a few reminders from MPI:

If an animal crosses...

- Dim your headlights—your brights may cause a deer to freeze on the road
- Slow down and be prepared to stop
- Blow your horn to scare the animal away
- Avoid hard swerving—you may lose control or crash into another vehicle
- Brake firmly to reduce the impact between an animal and your vehicle

If you hit an animal...

- Don't touch it — it may hurt you
- Move your car off the road, and call the police (204-437-2041) or have someone call for you

If there are any injuries, you require medical attention, or a vehicle is stopped in an unsafe fashion for other motorists, immediately call 9-11. Help will be on the way.

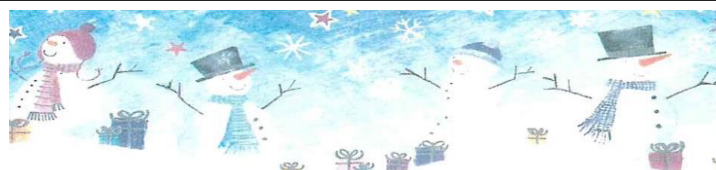

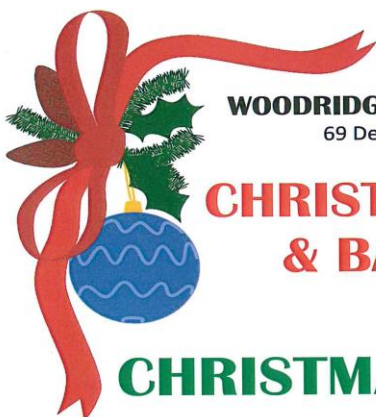
