Burnable Yard Waste Only!

Vassar and Sandilands waste disposal sites will be opened from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM on the following days:

VASSAR:
Saturday, May 4, 2019
Saturday, May 11, 2019

SANDILANDS:
Sunday, May 12, 2019

These dumps will only be open for the days listed above and will only be receiving yard waste such as trees, flax straw, grass, leaves, branches, and natural debris.

Household garbage, recycling, or any non-burnable debris will not be accepted at these dump sites.

Fire Pit Regulations



- An outdoor fire pit shall be enclosed on all sides and constructed of masonry, concrete, heavy gauge metal or other non-combustible materials;
- The outdoor fire pit shall not exceed 100cm in depth when measured from the bottom of the pit to the top of the pit opening and shall be at least 15cm in height when measured from the surrounding grade to the top of the pit opening;
- The outdoor fire pit opening shall not exceed 107cm in diameter or an area of 0.89 square meters and the width or lengths shall not be greater than 107cm;
- When in use, outdoor fire pits shall be continuously supervised by an adult;
- A means of extinguishment such as a portable fire extinguisher, pail of water, sand or garden hose shall be readily available on site. All fires must be completely extinguished before leaving the site.

RM Building Reminders

Piney Stuartburn Building Inspector, Gary Hora

All building applications can be picked up at the RM office or found on our website.

Building permits are required for:

- CONSTRUCTION OF ANY NEW BUILDING
- Attached and/or detached garages and/or carports
- Accessory buildings 108 sq. feet or more
- Temporary buildings (including temporarily (re)located buildings)
- Demolition of whole or part of a building
- Renovation projects that affect the structural integrity of a building and proper venting of plumbing

Development permits are different from a building permit. Development permits allow specific types of development on specific parcels of land in a community to proceed with the zoning and development bylaws of the RM of Piney. A development permit may stipulate some of the following conditions: the allowed use of the property, intensity of that use, building height, building site coverage, setbacks from property lines and other buildings and parking requirements.

***NEW* Temporary Structure Deposit Policy**

All temporary structures must be approved by the RM and will require a \$500.00 deposit per structure, prior to being moved onto the property. Contact the RM Office for more information.



Private Well Water Testing Days

Seine-Rat River Conservation District will be assisting residents with private well water testing for the presence of E.coli and Coliform bacteria. **The cost of private well water testing is \$22.31, including taxes, per sample.** Payment may be submitted by **exact cash or cheque ONLY**, with cheques made payable to Horizon Lab Ltd. Horizon Lab is also offering a new expedited service. Customers can pay an extra \$10 to have their bacteria water test report sent by the following business day.

Water sample bottles & application forms can be picked up in advance at the RM office. **Samples must be taken on the same day as the drop-off and submitted at the RM office prior to 10:00am** along with your completed application form, chain of custody form, and payment.
