Public Notice:

Through the MB-MN Transmission Line Project, the RM has approximately 440 cords of wood available (poplar, spruce, tamarack, and cedar) to residents in the RM of Piney at \$10/cord administration fee and will be available for pick-up at the Menisino Waste Disposal Site.

Permits are available at the RM office during regular office hours and will also be available at the dump site during the hours listed below. Limit of 1 permit per household, up to a maximum of 10 cords per permit. In the first two weeks, only 5 cords per permit may be accessed; after the end of the 2 week period, permittee can access an additional 5 cords to make up the maximum limit of 10 cords. There is no guarantee of wood volume or type. Permit holder will only be charged for wood taken; invoices and payments will be made through the RM office. You must obtain a permit and permit holder must be present in order to remove wood from the designated site.

Everything is cut in 8' lengths, so please come prepared to cut on-site or load whole. The RM is allowing the use of tractors, skidsteers and small equipment for loading. It is the responsibility of the operators to ensure the safety of all those within the work area. The use of Pickers/Log Loaders is not permitted. Wood must be picked up on-site, no delivery arrangements will be made. Wood is on a first come first serve basis and is for personal use only, not for resale.

Wood removal process starts Wednesday, March 4th, 2020 at 9:00am!
