"Fleetnet Policy"

Subject: Fleetnet

A. GOAL:

To establish a fleetnet policy that provides guidance for Council, employees and firefighters regarding the fleetnet radios. The intention of this policy is to establish a guideline stating the acceptable use of the fleetnets. All Council, employees and firefighters are responsible for knowing and understanding the policy. Fleetnet Radios initial use on a 911 call is to allow the District Chief, Deputy or Designate to respond to the page and clarify the information given by 911 for example; location, type of incident, notification of R.C.M.P. and Ambulance.

B. POLICY

I. Fire Departments

Four fleetnets will be issued and maintained per hall, one of which will remain in the fire hall for hall to site communication. One additional fleetnet shall be issued to the R.M. Fire Chief.

Fleetnet Radios initial use on a 911 call is to allow the District Chief, Deputy or Designate to respond to the page and clarify the information given by 911; eg: location, type of incident, notification of R.C.M.P. or Ambulance or relevant information.

While on scene at an incident, fleetnets are to be used for communications between the Incident Commander, District Chiefs and/or Deputies and/or Designate and Ambulance, 911, Mutual Aid or specific resources accessible by telephone for example: tow trucks.

Information is to be concise and at all times must protect the privacy of the individual. Appropriate language must be used at all times while using a fleetnet for communication.

Fleetnet use should be limited to inter agency or district to district use. VHF will be used for member to member communication.

II. Public Works

Fleetnets are to be used by Public Works Employees to coordinate jobsites and resources and provide safety for individuals working alone. One additional fleetnet shall be issued to the Public Works Supervisor.

III. <u>Emergency Operations Centre</u>

Fleetnets will distributed according to the needs determined by the Emergency Operations Centre.

C. RATIONELLE

Fleetnet Radios are provided to the Fire Departments to be used by the District Chief, Deputy or Designate for necessary communication.

D. <u>CONCLUSION:</u>

Fleetnets are a necessary wireless communication tool for The R.M. of Piney Fire Service, Public Works and Emergency Operation Centre.
