- 6. No commercial production of cannabis, the growing of cannabis at said property is solely for medical purposes personal use as permitted by Health Canada under the Access to Cannabis for Medical Purposes Regulation (ACMPR) Part 2;
- 7. Developer shall be required to enter into a development agreement at the developers expense;
- 8. A maximum of four medical purposes personal use registration as permitted by Health Canada shall be permitted on the property;
- 9. Annual fire safety inspection completed by the municipal inspector and the developer is to provide a fire response plan for the property;
- 10. The developer present annually to the RM Council a report of the prior year's operation and an outline for the next years operation, council shall have the opportunity to object to the proposal if there is concern that it doesn't meet the development agreement or conditions listed in the conditional use:
- 11. The conditional use may be revoked if all conditions outlined are not adhered to or followed. The RM shall provide one written notice of deficiency; the developer must immediately remedy the concern:
