

What Eliminating Education Property Taxes Means For You

The Manitoba government is providing tax relief to Manitobans by introducing a multi-year, phased elimination of education property taxes.

Starting in 2021, as a property owner in Manitoba, you will receive the **Education Property Tax Rebate** to reduce a portion of your education property taxes.

Rebate Cheques Coming Soon

Your Education Property Tax Rebate cheque from the Manitoba government will arrive **before** your municipal property taxes are due.

NOTE: You must pay the full balance owing on your property tax notice.

Residential and Farm Properties

Property owners will see a net reduction of 25% in school taxes payable for 2021.

- A rebate cheque will be issued for 25% of the school division special levy, as reflected on your 2021 municipal property tax notice.
- The Manitoba Education Property Tax Credit Advance will be reduced by 25% in 2021. This change appears in your 2021 municipal property tax notice.
- Existing rebates and credits (e.g., Seniors School Tax Rebate, Seniors Education Property Tax Credit, Farmland School Tax Rebate), will be proportionately reduced by 25% in 2021.
- Farm property owners must still apply for the Farmland School Tax Rebate.

Other Properties

Qualifying property owners will receive a rebate cheque representing 10% of the total school division special levy and education support levy payable for 2021.
