Traffic Gravel Haul

RM of Piney Public Works
2021-2022 Cost Comparison

The total cost for traffic gravel in 2021 was \$170,420.00 for 20,870 tonnes of gravel that was hauled and spread onto RM of Piney municipal gravel roads. The RM received funds from DFA (Disaster Financial Aid) to cover a portion of those costs.

For 2022, the total cost for traffic gravel including hauling, spreading, repairing municipal roads, and projects to date is \$190,659.18. This amount covers 17,536 tonnes of gravel. The RM may be receiving funds from DFA (Disaster Financial Aid) to cover a portion of these costs.

Eating: Engaged Kids
