AND WHEREAS this service would support a collective effort among municipalities, emergency services, and the Province to protect lives and reduce harm during critical incidents;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Rural Municipality of Piney advocate to the Province of Manitoba for the establishment of a protocol that enables municipalities to request the activation of Alert Ready push notifications in situations where there is an imminent threat to human life, including but not limited to wildland fires, ensuring that all individuals within the affected geographical area receive timely and critical emergency alerts;
