
One-Time Recovery Benefit Available For Wildfire Evacuees

A message from the Province of Manitoba Emergency Social Services Manager

On December 2, 2025, the Manitoba Government issued a media release announcing that the Manitoba government will match the Canadian Red Cross donations to support wildfire evacuees and affected businesses.

All evacuated Manitobans are eligible for a one-time recovery benefit funded through donations made to the Canadian Red Cross during the summer wildfires. Registered evacuees who previously received emergency financial assistance will be eligible for recovery support of \$120 per adult and \$65 per child.
