WHEREAS Canada Post has advised the RM of Piney that postal services currently operating within Woodridge will be displaced as a result of the retirement of the current Postmaster and the removal of the existing post office location; and

AND WHEREAS the Council of the RM of Piney recognizes the importance of maintaining local postal services within Woodridge and the significant impact that service disruptions may have on residents, businesses, seniors, and community organizations; and

AND WHEREAS the R.M. of Piney is a bilingual municipality that recognizes French language skills as a valuable asset that enhances service delivery to residents and reflects the linguistic character of the municipality; however, Council believes that French language proficiency should not be the determining factor in filling the position required to restore postal services within Woodridge; and

AND WHEREAS Council supports interim measures, including the installation of temporary community mailboxes or other temporary service arrangements, provided Canada Post remains committed to re-establishing a permanent postal service location within Woodridge as soon as reasonably possible;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council of the R.M. of Piney supports the staffing of the Woodridge postal service position with French language proficiency identified as a preferred qualification and valuable asset, but not a mandatory requirement, where such a requirement would delay the restoration of postal services to the community.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council supports the implementation of temporary service arrangements, including community mailboxes or other interim solutions, provided that Canada Post maintains its commitment to establishing a permanent postal service location within Woodridge.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council requests that Canada Post restore full postal services to Woodridge as quickly as possible and in a manner that minimizes inconvenience, travel requirements, and service disruptions for residents and businesses of the community.
