ADVANCE VOTING

For the purpose of accommodating persons who are qualified to vote, but who have reason to believe that they will be absent or otherwise unable to attend their proper voting place on election day, an advance voting opportunity will be located at Council Chambers of the Rural Municipality of Piney Office, 6092 Boundary Street in Vassar, and will be open on **Saturday, October 17th, 2026 between 8:00am and 8:00pm.**

IDENTIFICATION SHALL BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO VOTE

A person shall be required to produce one piece of government issued photo identification (for example - driver's license or passport) or at least two other documents that provide proof of identity.

APPLICATION TO VOTE BY SEALED ENVELOPE

A voter who is unable to go in person to the voting place or vote in advance, may apply in person, in writing, by fax, or by email to the senior election official at The Rural Municipality of Piney Office at 6092 Boundary Street in Vassar, MB R0A 2J0, email: office@rmofpiney.mb.ca, or fax: 204-437-2556.

If applying in person*, **a voter may apply between October 1st, 2026 and October 23rd, 2026.** *A voter applying in person may pick up a sealed envelope ballot package at the time of application.

If applying by Mail or fax**, **a voter may apply until October 23rd, 2026.** **A voter applying by mail or fax will receive a sealed envelope ballot package by regular post, or by making alternative arrangement with the senior election official.
